

# **Minutes of PCC Meeting**

Encouragement to keep all congregation members informed of progress on opening face to face worship and ministry. It would not be possible to reopen the building for worship on 14<sup>th</sup> March. But the return of the 'Rule of Six' expected on March 29<sup>th</sup> gives hope that we can meet once again face-to-face on Easter Sunday, April 4<sup>th</sup>. Estimation of likely demand might mean we run either one (9.30am) or two (9am and 10.30am) services.

b. 2021 current indicators.

David C advised that during the exceptional year a number of donors have moved or will shortly do so. Others have had to reduce donations. The impact on the current year of these changes implies a worst-case scenario of a £14k reduction to forecast annual income. He also reminded members that some give their annual donation in January which may give a false impression of the flow of income. Although the deficit in 2020 had been only £3k against a larger budgeted shortfall, expenditure would necessarily rise as many lock-down activities return to operating in-person.

Council accepted that the issues should be raised with the congregation.

8. Meeting with bishop, archdeacon, area dean, and deanery PCCs, 8<sup>th</sup> March Expectation that about 100 attendees from across the Diocese will hear proposals

on restructuring of the deanery in order to reduce Clergy numbers by about 20%. Howard W pointed out difficulty in that Clergy are not employees of the Diocese. Questions invited about the process. All are encouraged to attend the Zoom meeting and to pray for clarity and wisdom.
